

Leamington host Kidderminster Harriers in the final game of the 2025/26 season at Your Co-op Community Stadium.

*This game **WILL** be segregated. We anticipate a four-figure crowd for Saturday's game.*

Tickets

You can purchase tickets online and on the gate. We recommend using our [online ticketing portal](#) to purchase your tickets in order to minimise queues at the turnstiles. On the day one turnstile will be signed for online tickets so you can easily scan your ticket and gain entry and another turnstile will be accepting card and cash payments.

Please purchase "General Admission" tickets, whether you are a home fan or an away fan.

Kidderminster fans will be accommodated on the **North Bank** (opposite end to clubhouse). Admission will be gained via turnstiles at the far end of car park and top right-hand corner as you enter the complex. The segregated area capacity is 1,075 (100 seats and 75 standing undercover plus room for 900 standing uncovered) with the remainder uncovered terracing (we ask that seating priority be given to those who are older or have limited mobility – there is no additional fee to sit)

Leamington FC fans will have access to all other sections of the ground. Admission will be via the regular turnstiles at the clubhouse end of ground.

Car Parking

Car parking costs £3 when [bought before 11:59pm on Friday](#) and £5 when bought on Saturday online or both in cash or card on the day. We ask all supporters to either car-share or **make use of our free shuttle double decker service.**

Leamington FC season ticket holders get free parking when their ticket is shown at the gate, and blue badge holders must book their free tickets via the ticketing site link above.

We ask all supporters attending the game to either arrive a little bit earlier than usual or give themselves additional time to utilise the Bus Service. **PRIORITY** will be given to departure of bus services from the stadium site at the conclusion of the match.

There is a provision for overflow parking, should it be needed.

FREE Double Decker Bus Shuttle

A free double decker bus shuttle will run from Leamington Station, to our park & ride location at the Windmill Inn, to the ground. Both Leamington and Kidderminster fans are welcome to use this service.

Park & Ride parking is opposite the pub all along Ashbourne Drive, free on-road parking for a minimum of 200 cars next to the new Wickes store. Find the location on the map below:

Post-match, the service will leave for the station at 5pm, with further journeys back scheduled at 5:30pm and 6pm so supporters can mix with players and staff and watch post-match presentations.

For those coming to the Your Co-op Community Stadium for the first time, please note that although there is **‘ON-SITE’** parking for approximately 370 vehicles, there is **NO** alternative **‘on-street parking’**, as we are located on a busy country road with no pavements and surrounded by farmland.

Facilities

Your Co-op Community Stadium has facilities to please everyone! There is a burger van in the tunnel corner of the ground for home supporters, serving hot food and drinks with cash & card accepted. Likewise, there will be facilities in the North Bank for Kidderminster fans, including a bottle bar and food outlet, accepting both cash and card.

If Brakes fans don't feel like hot food but want something to snack on, then Debbie's Sweet Shop is the place to go. Hot drinks and cold snacks (including a wide selection of sweets) are all available from the sweet shop which you can find at the Harbury Lane End side of the ground, but please note this is cash only and home fans only.

Alcohol can be consumed on the terraces at our ground, and you can purchase it from our clubhouse which is situated in between the Harbury Lane End stand and Debbie's Sweet Shop as well as on the North Bank. All alcohol will be served in plastic containers.

The ground is covered on three of the four sides, as you walk in up from the turnstiles the covered Harbury Lane End behind the goal will be on your right. Straight ahead of you is the joint Main Stand and Car Park Terrace on the west side of the ground, on the Sheepside side of the ground sits the Mick Brady Stand, in honour of our Life President who passed away in 2020 and the North Bank behind the goal is the uncovered side which will host Kidderminster fans.

Clubhouse

The clubhouse can be used by Leamington fans and boasts a wide range of drinks! Our bar has live sports with Brentford vs Fulham on the big screen pre-match and the players will be present after the game to mix with fans in the bar and our 2025/26 Awards Evening.

There will be a bottle bar out of the fanzone on the North Bank for Kidderminster supporters, taking both cash and card.

Bus Travel

As well as our free shuttle, the 665 Stagecoach bus runs from the town to the ground. The outbound route leaves Upper Parade Stand K at 14:10 and reaches Your Co-op Community Stadium at 14:25. The inbound route leaves opposite Your Co-op Community Stadium at 17:17 and reaches Upper Parade at 17:34.

The closest stop to Royal Leamington Spa Railway Station to the ground is Crown Hotel, which [what3words](#) are dairy.legend.pops and the bus leaves at 14:14. Inbound, the closest stop is Charlotte Street ([what3words](#)march.hurt.loved) and the bus arrives there at 17:25. Both stops are within a 5 minute walk to Leamington Station. These 665 buses are also available from Long Itchington, Napton, Southam, Bishop's Itchington & Harbury, with all timings and stops on the timetable above.

Matchday Magazine

Our official matchday magazine "New Windmill Review" will be available to purchase for £3 just as you enter the turnstiles.

Turnstiles Opening Time

Turnstiles and all facilities inside the ground including the clubhouse and fanzone open at 1pm, two hours before kick off.

Live Coverage

Match updates can be found on our X, Bluesky, Threads, Instagram and Facebook pages and there will be live commentary on [BrakesLiveFM](#). Coverage will start approximately ten minutes from kick off.

Extended highlights and reaction will be available on Leamington FCTV the day after the game.

Disabled Supporters

Disabled fans entry prices are as above, however companions/carer will have free entry. There is no additional fee for seating.

The stadium has 3 wheelchair spaces in the main covered stand (situated in the centre with ramped access) with adjacent seating.

Disabled toilet facilities can be found in the main clubhouse (ramped access from pitchside) and also next to Main Stand opposite the Programme Shop and next to Men's Toilets. Any disabled Hereford fans will be permitted entry to the home areas to utilise toilet facilities.

Programme Shop

Our programme shop, ran by Andy Protheroe, will be open when the turnstiles do and is a must visit for all!

50/50 Draw

Donna and Yvonne will be making their way around the ground in the first half selling 50/50 tickets. These cost £1 each with half of the takings going to the club and the other half split between winners. The draw will be made and announced at half time.
